The Diakonie supports asylum seekers in Lauterbach and Friedberg throughout their asylum application. From asylum application through to its conclusion. We offer support with initial, second and repeat asylum applications along with other options of legalising your residency.

We support you ...

- with your application for asylum
- with a Dublin decision
- concerning qualifications, apprenticeships and working in Germany
- in cases of a temporary suspension of deportation (Duldung)
- in legalising your residency in Germany

We ...

- advise in German and English (Lauterbach), as well as German and Turkish (Friedberg)
- kindly ask you to bring a translator you trust
- advise you of your legal rights and support you with making your own informed decisions about your residency in Germany

Our principles: We ...

- advocate for the rights of refugees and promote equality and social participation
- foster autonomy and self-determination
- advise without discrimination based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, nationality, or political beliefs
- maintain data protection and confidentiality
- advise free of charge
